Principal's Report Katrina West

It is sad that we have had to cancel so many events this year due to COVID19. We are still waiting on update as to when excursions and events can recommence. At this stage most excursions have been postponed until Term 4, however depending on COVID19 may still not proceed, there are too many unknowns at this stage.

- Important at this time to keep our parents feeling connected to our school community at this time. Some of the ways the School has been connecting is through our online assemblies, online Liturgies, St Michael's News.
- Our families have managed these difficult circumstances with vary degrees of financial difficulty. Some have suffered serious income loss through either loss of work or business or have had COVID issues impact their family in other ways. Need to be mindful of what we ask of parents during this time.
- Grandparent's Day online for this year due to COVID, hence reason asking for grandparent photos.
- Still having bookfair this year. Kids will be able to dress up.
 No parents allowed on site.
 (Yasmine raised the question can we look in to the option
 of grandparents to purchase books online. School will
 check with librarian and let parents know).

School Wish List - for remainder of 2020:

As in past years (and agreed at last year's meeting), P&F agreed to fund:-

- 1. Bus Year 5 bus to Mary MacKillop Place \$900
- 2. Bus Year 6 Camp \$900

	3 Possibility of purchasing 1 Smart TV for classroom for Year 1. Cost approx. \$1,600 for wall mount or - \$2,300 for Smart TV/mobile stand (ex GST). Year 1 smartboard has died, we are managing on an old tv 10 years old and apple TV, however school will need to purchase a smart tv for classroom. Looking at mobile stand option – as we can move around classroom. Parent attendees agreed to purchase 1 smart tv for Year 1 if must be replaced: Liz, Yasmine, Linda (and Melissa who was having difficulties with audio in zoom but rang the school afterwards to confirm).
	4 Library Resources. Majority of our library resources come from P&F donation and book fair. Would P&F consider contributing any funds in 2020 for library resources? Yes
General Business	 Mother's Day gifts – Opportunity of having a loved one stall at end of year to sell those gifts with out Mother's Day on them Fundraising suggestions for year:- Christmas raffle. Ask for prizes to be donated. Cadbury Chocolate Boxes (raised by Karen Alexander) – Same as last year, offer to those who may be interested in selling. Not mandatory for all families. Cost of 20 boxes (minimum order) to purchase \$720. Profit on the sale of those 20 boxes is \$480. Majority agreed that this was an easy way to raise and happy to proceed. Online trivia night via zoom for families – (raised by Liz Martinovic). Snack pack offered? Logistics of how it would work need further investigating. Virtual runs/bike ride – (raised by Yasmine Gospel) Similar to a walkathon. Online bingo family night (raised by Linda Francis). Online option to sell tickets, fundraising, uniform shop items. Further investigation needed.
